Priced at \$799 and \$899, respectively, these machines offer good value for the desktop or small workgroup that needs color and faxing as well. The main difference between the two is the inclusion of two-sided printing for the Phaser 6115MFP/D, although it can be optionally added to the 6115MFP/N (\$349).

You can print at 20ppm in black-and-white and 5ppm in color, but copy speed in black-and-white is listed as 12ppm by Xerox.

Both machines come with a 200-sheet multipurpose tray. You can add a 500-sheet second input tray. The output uses a simple 100-sheet tray. A 50-sheet document feeder is also standard.

Standard memory is 128MB for both models, more than adequate for the host-based printing these models support. USB connectivity is standard on both machines, as is an Ethernet connection. Wireless connectivity is also an option. Both machines can scan in color, scan to PDF, and scan to email.

The fax modem for both models operates at 33.6kbps, and we estimate fax memory will accommodate approximately 320 pages.

Output costs are reasonable at the low end of the market. The black-and-white page cost is around 3.1 cents, while the color printing cost is estimated to be about 14.8 cents a page.

On the whole, these models have basic functionality with no surprises. Their pricing makes them very competitive for low-end users. These are solid machines that deserve our Editor's Choice Award.
